PETITION FOR DISSOLUTION OF MARRIAGE

COMES NOW the Petitioner, Jordan Sample, and for the cause of action against the Respondent, Riley Sample, alleges and states as follows:

1. Petitioner, Jordan Sample, is and has been a resident of the State of Oklahoma for more than six (6) months, and a resident of Oklahoma County for more than thirty (30) days, immediately preceding the filing of this Petition, as required by 43 O.S. § 102.
2. Petitioner and Respondent, Riley Sample, were married on June 20, 2015.
3. The parties are presently living separate and apart.
4. The parties are incompatible and the bonds of matrimony should be dissolved by reason of incompatibility (43 O.S. § 101).
5. Neither spouse is currently pregnant.
6. There are no minor children born of or adopted during this marriage.
7. The parties have acquired certain marital property and debts which should be equitably divided pursuant to 43 O.S. § 121.
8. Neither party requests spousal support; any right to spousal support is waived.

PRAYER FOR RELIEF

WHEREFORE, Petitioner prays that the Court grant a Decree of Dissolution of Marriage dissolving the marriage of the parties; equitably divide the marital property and debts; enter appropriate orders regarding the minor child(ren), if any, including custody, visitation, and child support; and grant such other and further relief as the Court deems just and equitable.
